

Why use Oilatum Cream? Oilatum Cream is an Emollient (softening, soothing agent) used in the treatment of atopic eczema, contact dermatitis, senile pruritis, and dry, sensitive skin; including ichthyosis (a scaly dry skin condition). It will help to moisturise the skin after washing and is suitable for people allergic to lanolin.

Caution: Avoid using the product if you are sensitive to any of the ingredients.

*Cetostearyl alcohol may cause local skin reactions (eg contact dermatitis).

DIRECTIONS

Apply to the affected area and rub in well. Use as often as required, or as directed by your pharmacist or doctor. Oilatum Cream is especially effective if applied immediately after washing, to counteract the loss of essential oils from the skin. Hospital users should follow in-use procedures for topical products.

Seek advice from your doctor or pharmacist if you are unsure how to use this product. If you experience irritation or any other unwanted effect ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice.

Do not use the product after the expiry date.
